Enclosed is a boat show move-in pass with your company's specific move-in date, time and location for your display in the North Hall. Also enclosed is an updated boat show floor plan for your display area. The move-in schedule and floor plan for all exhibitors can also be viewed at our exhibitor website: <http://www.seattleboatshow.com/exhibit>

Please arrive on time and at the correct door. If you know you are going to be late, please call the Lumen Field Show office at 206-381-8000. If you arrive late, your move-in may be delayed or, in the case of large boats, they may not be able to be displayed. Following are some specific instructions for the North Hall.

#### **NORTH HALL – MOVE IN**

Mark Cohen with Showboat Handlers LLC is managing the North Hall move-in. If you have questions about your boat move-in time please call Mark on his cell at (360) 348-5413.

Staging in the stadium's North Parking Lot will begin on Saturday, Jan. 29 at 7:00 a.m – 7:00 p.m. Specific boat staging requests should be referred to Katie McPhail - [katiemc@nmta.net](mailto:katiemc@nmta.net) or call the NMTA office at 206-634-0911.

- **STADIUM NORTH LOT – WEST HALF** – Boats and trailers can be staged in the West half of the North Lot only, starting Saturday, Jan. 29 at 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. No parking or empty trailer storage allowed in the North Lot.
- **EMPTY TRAILER STORAGE at MARINER'S GARAGE** - Exhibitors can store empty trailers at Mariner's Garage from Monday, January 31 to Tuesday, February 15 at no charge. The lot is located on the east side between Mariner's Garage and the railroad tracks. We recommend that exhibitors identify their trailer(s) with contact information. Please use space as efficiently as possible.
- **MOVE-IN HOURS** – The North Hall will be open for move-in from 6am – 8pm on Monday (1/31), Tuesday (2/1), Wednesday (2/2) and Thursday (2/3). Please see the enclosed move-in pass for your specific move-in time.
- All boats must have no more than one (1) gallon of gasoline or ¼ tank of diesel fuel. Propane and/or CNG is strictly prohibited. The Fire Marshall will be inspecting boats.
- All boats must be new and have 2020, 2021 or 2022 hull numbers.

- Exhibitors, staff, and boat cleaners can park in the Lumen Field parking garage for a discounted rate of \$5 during move-in and registration, January 30 – February 3. Concourse entrance doors are staffed at 7:00 am.
- **No Parking in the Stadium North Lot.** This area is reserved for boat staging only.

#### **NORTH HALL – MOVE OUT**

- North Hall exhibitors need to be completely out of the North Hall by 8:00 p.m. on Monday, February 14.
- A detailed move-out schedule will be distributed during the show.
- Exhibitors should be prepared to move-out whenever Showboat Handlers and NMTA schedule their move-out. Please note, move-out does not stop for the Super Bowl.

#### **EXHIBITOR REGISTRATION**

The Show Office at the Lumen Field will be open Noon to 5 PM on Monday, January 31 for exhibitor registration and pick up of exhibitor badges, parking passes and guest tickets.

Early exhibitor registration is available at the NMTA office January 26–28 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The NMTA office is located at 1900 N. Northlake Way, #233 Seattle WA 98103

The Exhibitor Service Center (GES, Edlen, Stadium IT) will be open noon 8a – 8p Tuesday February 1 – Thursday, February 3 for assistance with decorating, freight, electrical, and communication services.
