



Fishing and Crabbing Seminar Line-Up Announced for 2023 Seattle Boat Show

Seminars available in person and online

SEATTLE – December 9, 2022 – For anyone who has ever said, ‘the fishing was good, it was the catching that was bad’, there is help on the way! The [Seattle Boat Show](#) is back (February 3-11 2023), with its usual stellar lineup of free in-person fishing, crabbing and shrimping seminars. The \$119 dollar Seminar Package ticket includes multi-day admission to the show (a \$40 value) and a copy of the Waggoner Guide (\$45 value).
