Exhibitor Insurance Certificate Requirements

All exhibitors are required to submit a certificate of liability insurance prior to receiving their booth assignment. **Exhibitors without insurance cannot exhibit at the show.** Following is the information your insurance company will need.

INSURANCE ENDORSEMENT: Applicant shall maintain bodily injury and property damage insurance coverage, including contractual liability, in the minimum amounts of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate where aggregate limits apply, and shall name the Northwest Marine Trade Association (1900 N. Northlake Way, Seattle WA 98103), its employees, Officers, and Board of Trustees, King County (500 Fourth Ave. Seattle, WA 98104), First & Goal and PSA (800 Occidental Avenue South, Seattle WA 98134) and Port of Seattle (PO Box1209, Seattle, WA), its employees, Officers, and Board of Trustees as additional insured under the policy.

Applicant shall maintain all risk property insurance covering applicant's own property and property of others in the Applicant's care, custody, or control. Applicant agrees to waive subrogation with regards to the property coverage, against the Northwest Marine Trade Association and its employees, Officers, and Board of Trustees, First & Goal and PSA, Port of Seattle, and its employees and King County for loss of or damage to Applicant's property and property of others in the Applicant's care, custody or control. Certificates of insurance must be furnished to the NMTA prior to move-in. Applicant's insurance shall be primary in any and all claims.
